

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

^{*} AVK Series 815 Butterfly Valves are designed to be maintenance free. In a accidental instance, that the gearbox is over torqued, the Shear Key (810), or Hand Wheel Pin (813), may require replacement.

INTRODUCTION / DESCRIPTION

The AVK Series 815 Grooved End Butterfly Valves are UL/FM approved and designed to be trouble/maintenance free, for use in Fire Protection. They have a rated working pressure of 300 PSI and are available in 2½" through 8" sizes. This manual will provide you with the information needed to properly install and maintain the valve and to ensure a long service life.

RECEIVING AND STORAGE

Inspect valves upon receipt for damage in shipment. Unload all valves carefully to the ground without dropping. Never lift a valve by the Indicator Flag, or Gearbox electrical cord. Valves should be stored in a clean and dry area until installed to prevent weather related damage. Do not expose the discs to sunlight or ozone for any extended period of time. Store the valves with the disc in the open position. For long term storage the valves should be stored indoors.

INSPECTION PRIOR TO INSTALLATION

Make sure all mounting surfaces and disc seats are clean and free of foreign materials. Check the Gearbox bolting to the valve for any loosening during transit. If loose, tighten the mounting hardware. Open and close the valve to verify operation and proper stop adjustments for both the open and closed positions. Check that the valve rotation direction is correct and close the valve prior to installation.

INSTALLATION

WARNING: The line must be isolated, depressurized, and drained before installing/removing the valve to/from the system line. Failure to do so may cause pressure to be released resulting in severe injury or death.

NOTE: Before closing a fire protection system control valve for maintenance or inspection, permission to shut down the affected fire protection systems must be obtained from the proper authorities and all personnel who may be effected by this decision must be notified. Do not exceed 200 pound rim pull torque for hand wheels.

It is recommended that automatic sprinkler systems be inspected, tested, and maintained by a qualified inspection service.

Correct installation of the Series 815 Butterfly Valve is important for proper operation. It may be installed with flow in either direction and in either horizontal or vertical applications. The couplings used with Series 815 valves must be approved for fire protection service and installed in accordance with the manufacturers instructions. Series 815 valves may be installed with any schedule of pressure pipe or tubing that is listed or approved for fire protection. The Gearbox can be mounted in 90 degree alternate positions for ease of installation.

An electrical connection diagram for the Supervisory/Auxiliary Switch connection is mounted on the exterior of the gearbox. (See Fig. 2) Electrical and conduit connections are to be made in accordance with the authorities having jurisdiction and/or the National Electrical Code.



MAINTENANCE

The owner is responsible for the inspection, maintenance, and testing of their fire protection system and devices in accordance with the applicable standards of the National Fire Protection Association, and any other authorities having jurisdiction.

TOOLS

The following tool requirements are for gearbox repositioning and stop adjustment. Please refer to coupling manufacturer documentation for other tool requirements.
